CAPS = Additions to the statement

In accordance with federal and state laws, illegal discrimination in employment against any individual bed of race, color, religion, national origin, age, sex, veteran status, physical or mental disability, marital status changes in marital status, pregnancy or parenthood, or SEXUAL ORIENTATION is prohibiterisions affecting an individual's employment will be based on the individual's qualifications, abilities and performa as appropriate.

EFFECTIVE: The UAF Faculty Senate requests that first discussion of the amendment be placed on the Human Resources Committee agenda at the March BOR meeting.

RATIONALE: Under the current policy, students, staff and faculty could be discriminated against because of their sexual orientation. As an institution of higher learning, the University of Alaska should be setting an example to the rest of the state in terms of recognizing and respecting all of the diverse peoples of Alaska, adding sexual orientation to the policy, the university is further sending a message to all students, staff, and faculty that this is a place where they are welcome, accepted, and protected against discrimination.
